

FleetSafe Solutions Update on Marijuana Rescheduling



On December 18th, President Trump's [Executive Order](#) addressing the directive to proceed with the rescheduling of marijuana includes language that **preserves the U.S. Department of Transportation's authority to continue THC testing for safety-sensitive positions.**

The DOT marijuana classification remains a Schedule I drug under the Controlled Substances Act until any rescheduling process is finalized. Consequently, it is still prohibited for any safety-sensitive employee who is subject to drug testing under the Department of Transportation's regulations to use marijuana.

While the marijuana rescheduling process raises many questions nationwide, one thing is clear:

- DOT drug testing panels remain unchanged
- THC testing for safety-sensitive positions continues as required.
